Thank you for coming along on the walk which the Branscombe Project hosted.


This document displays the maps that were handed round and possibly you did not have time to examine properly or leisurely. The plats at Littlecombe have red stars and at Weston some of the plats have been outlined in red. The aerial photograph taken about 60 or 70 years after Victorian O.S. map of 1889 shows how many plats have been overgrown and lost. Both maps show more paths leading from the beaches up into the undercliff at Littlecombe Shoot and Weston Mouth.

Whilst giving an overview of the plats along this stretch of coast, Weston Mouth/Dunscombe Cliffs plats were highlighted as we know Branscombe men worked them. They are of course in the parish of Salcombe Regis. Working plats at Littlecombe and Weston ended in the 1960s, probably Hooken plats too.

The very old map of Berry Barton for 1763 shows ‘Little Garden Plot’ in several places, and is available on this website to view.
